- 1.5 Prices quoted should be net inclusive of all taxes and delivery must be in Kenya Shillings shall remain valid for 120 days from the closing date of the tender.
- 1.6 All pages of the tender documents must be numbered and signed/initialed by an authorized person. Further the tender submission must be securely bound. Failure to observe this will render your submission non-responsive thus disqualified.
- 1.7 Tender opening will be public and shall take place at the conference Room situated on 2nd Floor, Kencom House, Wing B, immediately after the above stated date and time in the presence of tenderers or their representatives who choose to attend. Late bids will be returned unopened.
